Workshop for young researchers: "Environmental and Resource Economics"

14 – 15 October 2021, Carl von Ossietzky University Oldenburg

The "Ausschuss für Umwelt- und Ressourcenökonomie (AURÖ) im Verein für Socialpolitik" and the Institute of Economics at the Carl von Ossietzky University Oldenburg cordially invite you to the annual workshop for young researchers in "Environmental and Resource Economics".

The workshop is aimed at young researchers (esp. PhD students and Postdocs), especially from Germany, Austria, and Switzerland. Contributions from all fields of environmental and resource economics are welcome. As every year, the workshop offers the opportunity to present the own research to a small, professionally qualified audience and to discuss it with others. In addition, the workshop offers the opportunity to establish contacts with other young scientists in German-speaking countries and exchange experiences.

The workshop will be led by the chairs of Economic Policy (Prof. Dr. Christoph Böhringer), Public Economics (Prof. Dr. Carsten Helm), Applied Microeconomics (Prof. Cristian Huse, PhD) and Environmental and Energy Economics (Jun.-Prof. Dr. Emmanuel Asane-Otoo), all of which have an environmental economics focus.

Submission of contributions by Thursday, 19 August 2021, should be in the form of a meaningful abstract of approx. 1-2 pages outlining the research question, method and (expected) results. The abstract must contain the title of the contribution, as well as the name, institutional affiliation and email address of all authors. It should be in PDF format and submitted by email to carsten.helm@uni-oldenburg.de.

By **2 September 2021**, the person submitting the abstract will be informed whether his or her contribution has been accepted for the workshop. **Binding registration for the workshop is by 23 September 2021** and includes submitting a complete paper (draft versions are permitted) in PDF format.
