



Gender morphology: feminisation of personal nouns





The same meaning exists twice within one grammatical category;
Relevance of gender marking?

If possible, do not use gender-marking morphology

Diachronically: metaphoric animacy

Middle Dutch (// Middle High German): Metaphoric personification of abstract concepts and natural objects (*wisdom, poverty, soul; moon, root, back*)
PN's in -ster, Corpus Middelnederlands (#15)

- i. dat is die **wortel** / nochtans is si **voetster** ende begin van alle den boem
- ii. O here ghif mi die **wijsheit** / **besitster** dijnre stolen ende wil mi niet verwerpen van dinen kinderen
- iii. die **maen** is een scierheyt des nachts ende is moeder alle der humoren / **dienster** ende vrouwe vander zee
- iv. vntreue ist ir **ratgebinne** (MHG, cf. Hennig 1991)

Diachronically: metonymic animacy

Modern Dutch: metonymic personification of mainly collectives
(SketchEngine/nlTenTen14 & TS14-21: *de X als Y-ster*, #23)

- Collectives: *Kerk* (x5), *gemeente* (x3), *overheid* (x3), *commissie* (x3), *PLO*, *universiteit*, *vennootschap*
e.g., *de Kerk als behoedster van de hemelse waarheid*
- Non-collectives: *aarde* (x2), *bloem* (x2), *politiek*, *zon*
e.g., *de zon als schenkster van leven*

→ No grammatical cue on the antecedent for gender attribution to inanimates;
association of collectives with traditionally female gender roles (Szczepaniak 2014)

Diachronically: metonymic animacy

Data from Scott (2009): any PN with an inanimate referent, any fem. suffix


- Corpus Gesproken Nederlands (no data);
 - INL 27 Miljoen Woorden Krantencorpus 1995;
 - INL 38 Miljoen Woorden Corpus 1996.
- } #108

105 PN's have a collective noun as an antecedent

Personification & (non-)gendered language systems


Dutch: *de X als Y-ster* (e.g., *de Kerk als behoedster*) in nLTenTen14 + TS14-21

- Corpus size: 3.6 bln tokens
- PN's ending in *-ster* with inanimate referent: 23
- # per billion: **6,4**




Diachronically: German

German: DWDS, Historical corpora (1469-1965): *die X als Y-erin* (#137)
e.g., *die Nationalgarde als Wächterin der bürgerlichen Ordnung*, 1840



Diachronically: German


German: SketchEngine/TS 03-2021: *die X als Y-erin* (#150)
e.g., *die CDU als Hauptverliererin*



Personification & (non-)gendered language systems

German: *die X als Y-erin* (e.g., *die CDU als Hauptverliererin*)

- Corpus size: 126.7 mln tokens
- PN's ending in *-erin* with inanimate referent: 150
- # per billion: **1185**



→ 200x more frequent in German than in Dutch

Semantics of gender

Dan Slobin's concept of *thinking for speaking*

“Language [...] surely directs us to **attend** – while speaking – to the dimensions of experience that are enshrined in grammatical categories.”
(Slobin 1996: 71)

Encoding of conceptual gender in grammar



Attend to conceptual gender when using language/grammatical gender

Conclusion

grammatical gender \longleftrightarrow conceptual gender

Conceptual gender interpretations are activated through grammatical gender
if the corresponding grammatical categories are available
(*die CDU als Verliererin* vs. *de Kerk als hoeder*)

Conceptual-gender associations with grammatical gender disappear when the corresponding grammatical categories disappear



Dutch: decrease in the use of feminizing morphology in different contexts

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

Feminisation

ze is een... actrice, atlete, heldin, zangeres

Neutralisation

ze is een... advocaat, kunstenaar, journalist, student
