Research experience

My research experience started in Groningen with my MA thesis on the production of determiners in Dutch and German agrammatic aphasia (supervisor: prof. dr. R. Bastiaanse). A similar line of research was pursued during my PhD studies, in which I focused on case assignment in aphasia, and studied this from a cross-linguistic perspective (Dutch, German, Russian, Hungarian, Hebrew) and with several methods (spontaneous speech analysis, sentence elicitation, picture description). During my postdoc position, I worked with (among other people) dr. Sergey Avrutin, and extended my experience on aphasia, switching to a slightly different topic (comprehension and production of pronouns) and different methodology (truth value judgment task, picture selection and cross-modal lexical interference, an online reaction time method). I also investigated the production and comprehension of pronouns and determiners in language development. Here too, the research was often cross-linguistic (Dutch, Spanish). After moving to the university of Oldenburg, I followed up on my research on agrammatic aphasia and normal language development (in cooperation with -among other- people prof. dr. Friedmann, Tel Aviv university, prof. dr. Schulz Frankfurt university, and prof. dr. Hamann, Oldenburg university).

I further increased my research experience, by studying language processing in healthy adults (work with prof. dr. Schumacher (Burkhardt)), focusing on the processing of pronouns and reflexives. I also cooperated with audiologists (e.g. prof. dr. Birger Kollmeier, dr. Thomas Brand), on a project on ‘understanding language’ in which we combined audiological and psycholinguistic expertise. Within the cluster of excellence Hearing for All, we follow up on this research, and examine sentence comprehension and processing in younger and older adults with and without hearing impairment, as well as hearing impaired children and children who are implanted with a cochlear implant (CI). The latter work is done in cooperation with prof. Friedmann (Tel Aviv) and Prof Hendriks (Groningen). Finally, I build up an ERP and eyetracking lab, and study code switching in foreign language learners, with the use of ERP (this work is done in cooperation with prof. Hentschel and dr. Zeller from the Slavic Department), as well as sentence processing. Recently, my cooperation with the neuropsychologists from the university of Oldenburg (Thiel, Rieger) are strengthened, we are jointly working on a neuroimaging project (fMRI) in which the effects of hearing impairment and hearing aids on sentence processing are examined.

Linguistically, my work focuses on pronominal elements, as well as word order effects in Wh-questions and relative clauses, and the role of morphosyntactic information on this (case, gender, agreement). This I aim to address from a crosslinguistic perspective with a focus on Dutch and German.
