Enrollment numbers

Student numbers increased significantly in the last academic year. In the Winter semester 2024/2025, the number of students in the first semester was 79, corresponding to a capacity utilization of 152%.

Reaccreditation

The degree program was reaccredited without conditions in November 2024. However, the following recommendations were made: "The degree program should determine for which existing courses a larger number of places is desired. In addition, students should be clearly informed in advance which courses have limited enrollment. For courses with particularly high demand, it should be examined whether it is possible to expand the offering accordingly."
