## Changes to the examination regulations for WS2022/2023

The general part of the examination regulations has been changed in two essential points:

\$10(3) has been deleted. The type and number of module examinations can no longer be changed with the approval of the study commission. The type and number of module examinations must now always correspond to the information for the respective module in the examination regulations.

§23(3) has been deleted. It is now no longer possible to delete module grades for the overall result.

The interdisciplinary elective area (interdisziplinärer Wahlpflichtbereich) was introduced in the course-specific part of the examination regulations. This currently contains the free selectable master module and the new module "Current Topics and Methods in Marine Environmental Sciences", previously called the container module.

In the elective area "Biology, Ecology", the module "Mass Spectrometry in Chemical Ecology" (module responsibility: Schupp) and in the elective area "mathematical modelling" the module "Biogeochemical Modeling" (module responsibility: Lennartz) are now offered.

Furthermore, all changes mentioned by those responsible for the module have been taken into account.

We recently established this new module. In this module, all lecturers can offer 3 CP or 6 CP courses. No change in the examination regulations is necessary for this, so that current topics can be offered at short notice. No courses have been registered for this module for the winter term. It would be desirable if at least 6 credits were registered for courses in the future so that the module can be offered to students.

Possible forms of events: Lecture, seminar, exercise, internship, colloquium Possible forms of examination: presentation, homework, oral examination, practical exercise, written exam
