Background

The Network University Medicine (NUM)* (grant number: 01KX2021) was established in March 2020 to coordinate COVID-19-research and to build up a sustainable medical research infrastructure in Germany.

The NUM focuses on clinical research and develops guidelines and recommendations to improve patient care and to distribute Best Practice methods. To reach these goals the BMBF provides 195 Mio. Euros for infrastructure and research projects so far in two funding periods (03/20-12/21 and 01/22-12/24). All 36 German University medicine locations, including the University medicine
