Freely available publications increase visibility and re-use of research results.



Open Access Publishing is not for free ...

OA publications of books and journal articles more often than not cost money. Publishers charge socalled Article and Book Processing



led Article and Book Processing Charges (APC/BPC) and invoice authors and/or editors.

Funding Requirements

You are researcher at a university, a university of applied sciences, an archive or a museum of the state of Lower Saxony (additional requirements might apply).



What kind of publications will be financed?

- Publications whose scientific quality has been assured e.g. through a peer review;
- Articles in journals or compilations that are freely available in toto and immediately upon publication;
- Monographs (incl. outstanding dissertation and habilitation theses);
- Compilations;
- Scientific/scholarly editions.

NiedersachsenOPEN Publication Fund

The NiedersachsenOPEN publication fund offers a service to finance open access publication charges through your library.

APC up to 2,500 Euros (incl. VAT) will be covered, BPC support is calculated depending on the publisher's quote.

How it works

- Fill in the form and submit it with the publisher's quote to your library.
- 2. Wait for the approval.
- 3. The publisher's invoice will be paid or co-financed by the library.
