SCARE Talks

- Each SCARE doctor candidate will present his/her progress, the accomplished tasks during the last period, and research plans for the next period.
- The duration of each talk is 20 minutes, followed by 10 minutes of discussion

Workshop(s)

- In advance to the workshop, each participant is asked to think of one personal topic he/she wants to address with one/some other SCARE participant(s), as well as the objective(s) he/she wants to achieve by the joint work on that topic.
- The topics and goals are restricted no more than that they should be related to SCARE. Among others, exemplary goals could be knowledge acquisition, identification and suggestion of cooperation potentials, discussion of related work, writing a joint paper draft, developing a common model/demonstrator concept or even coding of models, interfaces and tools.
- In workshop session WS1 each participant gives a 2-minute-introduction to his/her personal workshop-topic and the goal(s) he/she wants to achieve by that. All topics are sorted by possible similarities and noted on a session board. Voting and agreeing on the topics with the most common interest, we build groups which deal with those topics during sessions WS2 and WS3.
- Sessions WS2/WS3 take 60 min, including time for conclusion and documentation.
- If a group finishes their topic, they cross it out at the session board and either agree to change to remaining topics or they agree on new topics, adding them to the session board for others to join.
- In session WS4 every group is asked to present a 5min summary of their results.
