Waste disposal and recycling collection

Please put your bins, paper bins and yellow bags/bins on the street at 7 a.m. on collection days.

One-off collection of residual and organic waste

You can organise an additional collection with a 50L standard waste bag (only for residual waste) or a waste container with one-off collection markings on (residual waste and organic waste). The standard waste bag and one-off collection stamps for the waste container (according to volume) can be bought at the following locations:

- City Office Mitte, Pferdemarkt 14
- City Office Nord, Stiller Weg 10
- Waste Management Services, Wehdestraße 70
- Recycling Facilities Neuenwege, Barkenweg 6
- Recycling Facilities Langenweg, Felix-Wankel-Straße 7

Bulk waste and garden waste

To acquire a bulk waste (up to four cubic metres maximum) or garden waste card, you will have to pay a one-off fee for the collection. You can get the card from the same places as the stamps for the one-off collections (see above). Send in the card and then you will receive an appointment for the removal, or use our online services at www.awb-oldenburg.de. In addition, you have the option of disposing of up to two cubic metres of waste at the recycling facilities at Neuenwege (Barkenweg 6) or at Langenweg (Felix-Wankel-Straße 7) for a flat fee. Quantities of over two cubic metres are solely to be delivered to the Waste Treatment Plant Neuenwege (Barkenweg 3) where you will be charged depending on the weight. Container rental (Tel.: 57050-27)

For the short-term disposal of larger quantities of waste, the AWB offers containers in different sizes, ranging from 8 to 27 cubic metres, for bulk waste, construction waste, excavated soil and wood waste as well as compostable garden waste.

Electronic waste

Quantities of up to two cubic metres can be disposed of at Recycling Facilities Neuenwege (Barkenweg 6) or Langenweg (Felix-Wankel-Straße 7), anything over two cubic metres must be disposed of at the Waste Treatment Plant (Barkenweg 3). Collection as part of the bulk waste collection or disposal at the mobile hazardous waste collection (only small devices) is equally possible. Waste glass

Please sort waste glass according to colour and dispose of in the corresponding glass containers. Caps belong in the yellow bag! Container disposal times, only on working days from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m.

Construction waste and excavated soil

Construction waste is to be separated and delivered according to mineral composition, wood, metal, glass and plastic. This waste, as well as excavated soil, can be disposed of for a fee at the Recycling Facilities Neuenwege (Barkenweg 6) and Langenweg (no disposal of waste from construction sites), for amounts of up to two cubic metres. Amounts over two cubic meters can be disposed of at the Waste Treatment Plant Neuenwege (Barkenweg 3). Mixed construction waste will not be accepted. Mineral wool should only be delivered when packaged.

CDs/DVDs and corks

Hazardous waste from private households

Hazardous waste can be disposed of at the Recycling Facilities Neuenwege (Barkenweg 6) or Langenweg (Felix-Wankel-Straße 7). Furthermore, there is the option of disposing of special waste at the mobile hazardous waste collection.
