

Exchange Student Pre-Arrival Information

1. Recommended Arrival Date: Aug. 30th(THU), 2018

- For on-campus housing check-in students -

We recommend you arrive on Thursday, August 30th, 2018 in the afternoon so that your SeoulMate can assist in on-campus dormitory check-in. Dormitory check-in is available from August 28th (Tue), 15:00 but there is no assistance from your SeoulMate if you arrive before August 30th (Thu), 2018.

- For off-campus housing check-in students -

Students who stay in off-campus housing will be guided from off-campus housing office. Arrival date is up to you and make sure to be in Seoul before orientation date (August 31st, 10:00). There is no assistance from SeoulMate.

2. Transportation to University of Seoul

You will need to arrange your own transportation to the university. Shuttle services and public transportations are available from Incheon International Airport.

Your final destination:

Student Dormitory (생활관 Saeng-hwal-guan), University of Seoul (서울시립대학교. Seoul Sirip Dae-hak-kyo) 163 Seoulsiripdae-ro, Dongdaemun-gu, Seoul, 02504, Korea

1) By Limousine Bus from Incheon International Airport

You are advised to find the bus stop "5B" or "11B" at the exit of Incheon International Airport Terminal 1 and the bus stop "No.30" of Terminal 2. The limousine, #6002, will take you to Cheongryangni, the bus's final destination. The fare of limousine is 10,000 KRW. You may 1) Get off at the Cheongryangni stop and take a taxi or take a bus to the University of Seoul, or 2) Wait a little while until the bus heads to the next stop and the next stop will be University of Seoul.



2) By Taxi from Incheon International Airport

From the airport, it costs approximately 80,000 - 90,000 KRW by taxi up for 4 people to the University of Seoul. The fare of regular taxi starts from 3,000 KRW, while deluxe taxis start from 5,000 KRW. Most taxi drivers know the direction to the University of Seoul, pronounced as 'Seoul Sirip Dae-hak-yo'.

3) Using Professional Airport Pick-up Service

If you prefer to use a professional airport pick-up service, you must make a reservation at +82 32 743 7911. The cost is about 85,000 KRW (up to 4 people) and its website can be found at http://www.airhelp.co.kr

4) By Subway from Incheon International Airport

You may use the metro if you are familiar with the system. You will have to make a transfer at Seoul station (line1). It is not recommended if you are with big luggage, but it is a little cheaper and there is no traffic.



5) By Subway from Kimpo International Airport

If your flight arrives at Kimpo International Airport you are advised to use subway (Line 5). Get off at Dapsimni station which is the closest station from University of Seoul and take a taxi to the University of Seoul at Exit 3 or 4. The taxi fare from Dapsimni station to the University of Seoul (pronounced 'Seoul Sirip Dae-hak-kyo', 서울시립대학교 in Korean) is around 4,000 KRW.





3. Housing

UOS offers on-campus housing and off-campus housing to international exchange students during their stay.

1) On-campus housing

Housing Office will have finished room assignments a week before semester starts. Please note that UOS Housing Office has the authority for room assignment. <u>Please note that the check-in is available from August 28th (Tue), 15:00.</u> The housing office is located on the 1st Floor of the International House Building for check-in. Please refer to <u>global.uos.ac.kr \rightarrow For International Students \rightarrow Living in Seoul \rightarrow After Arrival Information \rightarrow On-campus Housing for more detailed information.</u>

*UOS Scholarship recipients (incl. ISEP student) are automatically allocated to Residence Hall.

2) Off-campus Housing

We recommend two off-campus housings: URSeoul(<u>http://urseoul.com</u>) & CMS-INN(<u>www.cmsinn.com</u>) You must contact and do contract with your landlord to check in. Rooms are first come and first served. Please refer to attached files for more detailed information for each off-campus housing option.

IMPORTANT : We only offer on-campus housing to the students whose home university offer on-campus housing to UOS students in reciprocity. Please make sure to check the housing allocation(on-campus or off-campus) listed in the admission letter!!
