Credit system

The European Credit Transfer System ECTS is used in Finland. Full-time studies during one semester amounts to 30 ECTS, or 60 ECTS during one academic year.

Practical information

Accommodation	<p>Accommodation – incoming students apply for accommodation themselves, either through any of the available local student housing foundations, or on the private market. Students arriving for autumn semester are strongly advised to reserve housing from 1 August, due to high demand</p> <p>→ uwasa.fi/en/education/studying-and-living-finland/information-about-vaasa/accommodation-vaasa</p>
Fees	<p>Fees – exchange students have no additional mandatory fees. The Student Union fee is voluntary for exchange students, however mandatory for degree-seeking and double degree students.</p> <p>→ vyy.fi/en/for-students/membership</p>
Insurance	<p>Insurance – exchange students are advised to obtain necessary personal insurances before arrival. Insurances should cover costs resulting from illness or accidents (medical treatment and hospitalisation, medication, and costs for interruption of the exchange), as well as insurances for personal belongings and third-party liability.</p>
Permits	<p>Permits – citizens of EU Member States, Iceland, Liechtenstein, Norway or Switzerland, do not need a residence permit for Finland, but stays exceeding three months, need to register their right of residence at a local service point of the Digital and Population Data Services Agency DVV. Other nationalities need to apply for a residence permit, please consult the Finnish Immigration Service.</p> <p>→ migri.fi/en</p>
Pick-up service	<p>Pick-up service – offered only to incoming exchange students who arrive on the official arrival day</p>

Force Majeure

The exchange period can be postponed or cancelled by the decisions of the authorities in Finland, or by the University of Vaasa due to force majeure, and in particular in case of strikes, natural disasters, epidemics, fires, floods, storms, malicious acts or war. In these cases, the exchange student and the university will both be responsible for their own costs and expenses related to the postponing or cancelling the exchange period.
