STUDENT EXPERIENCE REPORT

Preparation (planning, organisation, and application at the host institution)

The professors of the University of Perpignan are easily contactable, and they provide all the information that you need in advance. All the paperwork is rather smooth and clear. If you have any questions, feel free to send them e-mails and you will be well-informed within no time.

Travel and arrival

Font-Romeu can be reached by two options. Easier one is to get the so called "1€ Bus" operating between the French city Perpignan. (Please see the link below)

However, flights to Perpignan are quite expensive. A cheaper option might be taking the flight to Barcelona and then taking the train to the French town Latour-de-Carol. At this train station, there is also a "1€ Bus" station. Font-Romeu is then reachable in less than 30 minutes with the bus going to the Perpignan direction. It is strongly advised that you check the schedule for the bus before you take the train because Latour de Carol is a remote location and you may have to hitchhike if there are no busses once you arrive.

Accommodation

Accommodation is not expensive, however quite hard to find especially for foreigners. We have had the help of a French colleague for the accommodation and end up staying at a beautiful place with a stunning view for only $200 \in$ per month cold rent. Below you can see photos from our balcony.



Studying at the host university (courses, academic performance/credits, support, credit transfer)

For the EUREC master students everything about the structure of the courses and credits are pre-arranged. Therefore, no problems occurred as expected. The education includes lots of practical laboratory works and homework.
