EU Students

First Session:

July 13 – 17: application

July 20 – 25: admission tests – Faculty of Music Performance

July 27 – 29: admission tests – Faculty of Theoretical Studies

Second Session:

September 10 – 11: application

September 14 – 17: admission tests – all faculties

*Candidates who have obtained their high school graduation diploma in a European country other than Romania must receive a **Validation of Studies Certificate** from the **Romanian National Centre for the Recognition and Validation of Diplomas** (hereby referred to as **C.N.R.E.D**), thus all documents required for the recognition of studies completed abroad must be sent, in original and legally certified copy, scanned, via e-mail, with at least one month before the entrance examination registration deadline.*

The folder will be subsequently sent to C.N.R.E.D. by the ANMGD representative, through the PCUe.

The application folder will be submitted via e-mail, and will include the following documents:

1. **The affidavit** concerning the conformity with the original of the documents submitted – filled in, signed by the candidate (scanned);

2. **Standardized application form**, to be obtained from the faculty secretary's office, filled in, signed by the candidate (scanned);
3. A **Cover Letter** bearing the institution's representative electronic signature;*

4. **Application Form** filed in and signed by the candidate (scanned);*
5. **Baccalaureate Diploma or its equivalent** (or a certificate issued by the upper secondary school, attesting to the overall average obtained by the candidate, in case the diploma has not been issued yet), the originals and legally certified translations (scanned) *
6. **Accademic Records**, the originals and legally certified translations (scanned);*
7. **Identity Card (Passport**, valid for at least 6 months after the acceptance to studies letter was issued, or other Identity Document, scanned)*
8. **Birth certificate**, the original and legally certified translation (scanned);*
9. **Wedding Certificate** (if applicable) the original and legally certified translation (scanned);*
10. **Identity Card** (scanned);
11. **Medical certificate** (in a widespread international language) proving that the candidate is physically and mentally fit to pursue academic studies and has no contagious disease;
Phoniatics examination for the *Opera singing* candidates (scanned);
12. **Portfolio** (posters, competition diplomas, awards, if applicable) with regard to the candidate's artistic activity (scanned);
13. **A recent photography**, .jpg format;

At the moment of confirming the place of study, by conveying the standard confirmation form to the faculty's secretary office, the candidates will also submit their application folder in original and photocopies, including four photographs ¾ color (identity card type).

Language Competence:

At the National Academy of Music Gheorghe Dima the courses are held in Romanian, except for the Music programme (Faculty for Theoretical Studies), which is taught in English. Therefore, the foreign candidates must prove their Romanian Language Competences by the following means:

- presenting graduation documents or school situation records attesting the completion of **at least four consecutive years** with tuition in Romanian, within the national education system in a Romanian or foreign based institution;
- candidates who possess Romanian language skills acquired in non-formal or informal contexts may obtain a certificate attesting the fact, following an evaluation by the authorized institutions;
- present **certificates or attestations of linguistic competency of a minimum B1 level** (as defined by in the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages), issued by the accredited higher education institution that organize the Romanian language preparatory year for foreign students, the Romanian Language lectorates established by the Romanian Language Institute, or the Romanian Cultural Institute.

Otherwise, the candidates will attend a preparatory year of Romanian language organized by the accredited higher education institutions, according to the legal provisions in force:

The application folders will be sent via e-mail at paula.sandor@amgd.ro (the International Students Representative – Paula Șandor), or relatii.externe@amgd.ro bearing the **Bachelor Admission Application** title.

According to the each specialty's requirements, the folders will comprise video links (youtube for the Faculty of Music Performance, Instruments & Canto), or the .pdf files (portfolios for e.g. – Faculty of Theoretical Studies, Composition).

On-line tests (skills, interviews, practical or oral tests) will be held on ZOOM / Skype or similar platforms. The candidates will receive via e-mail the access credentials and the schedule, which must be strictly followed.

All candidates must present their identity cards at the beginning of the video recordings, as well as the *on-line* tests.
