General information

The Czech Republic (Czechia) is a landlocked country located in Central Europe bordered by Germany, Poland, Slovakia and Austria. The country is divided into thirteen regions, plus the capital city and region of Prague.

Useful facts

The Czech economy is based on industry and manufacturing, especially the automotive sector. Car production alone makes up almost 20% of all exports and hundreds of thousands of people across the country work in the industry.

The official language is Czech. It is a Slavic language that is mutually intelligible with Slovak, and roughly intelligible with Polish.

While approximately 86% of our neighbours believe in God, only 22% Czechs say the same thing. Czechs support legal abortions (79%) and same-sex marriage (58%).

Traditions

Easter

In the Czech Republic, the tradition is that men chase women around the village and spank them softly with a whip woven from branches. Don't worry, they do it to guarantee the women another healthy year and to preserve their youth and beauty.





Wine harvest

"Vinobran" is a traditional Czech grape harvest festival celebrating the end of the winegrowing season. It features vibrant parades, folk music, dancing, and the tasting of local wines. The festivities reflect the rich cultural heritage and communal spirit of the Czech wine regions.

St. Nicholas

"Mikulášská obchůzka" is a traditional Czech St. Nicholas procession held on December 5th. St. Nicholas, accompanied by an angel and a devil, visits homes to reward wellbehaved children with treats and remind the naughty ones to improve. This festive event blends joy, folklore, and a touch of moral teaching.



Weather

The climate of the Czech Republic varies from season to season.

During summer, temperatures can rise up to 35 °C. Winters (December-March) can be either mild or harsh with temperatures below 0 °C. Do not forget to bring a warm coat!

Bring cash, cashless payment methods can sometimes be unreliable! CZK 8,000 should cover the deposit at the Halls of Residence, transportation from Prague airport and some minor expenses.

Hradec Králové lies at the confluence of the Elbe River and the Orlice River. It is about an hour's drive from Prague. With a population of just under a 100,000, the capital of the Hradec Králové region is also known as a university town.

Transportation in Hradec Králové

Hradec Králové has an extensive cycling network and the best way to get around the city is on **bikes** and **scooters**. The cycling network is about **80 km long**. If you don't want to buy a bike, you can use the **Nextbike** service.

All trolley and electric bus timetables are available at the **Public Transport Company of Hradec Králové** website. Alternatively, you can also use the **IDOS** mobile app.





Our Philosophical Faculty prepared a thorough guide for transportation around Hradec. Check it out.



Main Railway Station and Public Transport Terminal

The Czech Republic has a pretty neat railway net. You probably arrived to the **Main Railway Station in Hradec**, hop on a train and discover more beautiful cities. Connections information and tickets available in **"Můj vlak"** app.





Public Transport Terminal is a HUB for buses. There are various transport companies but all information is gathered there.

Just remember that bus lines 24 and 4 will get you to *Palachova* bus stop (the dorms) and line 2 to *Na Brně* bus stop (also close to the dorms).







The most common one-way ticket for public transportation can be bought at any newspaper stand.

City card

New ticketing system lets you manage everything online with a virtual card linked to your bank card (physical or virtual). All information is securely stored on the transport company's servers.



In 2023, the Hradec Kralové City Transport introduced contactless bank card payment in all buses and trolleys.

nextbike

Nextbike is a bicycle-sharing service and an official partner of UHK. There are four stations in close vicinity to UHK. Between buildings C and B, in front of building E, in front of building S and right next to the Palachovy dorms.

Handy information & basic vocabulary

Academic year

At UHK, the academic year has two semesters - the winter semester (September-February) and the summer semester (February-June). Lessons cover a 13-week period.

Courses

Czech students take obligatory, semi-obligatory and voluntary courses. Your study plan is different and tailor-made just for you. Please remember to submit your preferences to the International Office in time!

Lectures

With some courses, a guarantor (associate professor or professor) may give non-obligatory lectures. You need to attend these lectures if you want to pass the course.

Seminars

Apart from lectures, you may also need to attend seminars. These are more practical and are designed to further the knowledge you gain at lectures. They are also **obligatory**, so make sure you show up!
Credits

UHK uses the European Credit Transfer and Accumulation System (ECTS). You gain credits for successfully passing a course.

Pre-exams

You must meet certain criteria to be allowed to sit the final course test. You may be required to write an essay or give a presentation, for example.

Exams

Exams can be written, oral or practical. Depending on how you do in your exam, you'll get a/n A, B, C, D, E or F. If you get an **F**, you fail the course. Please keep in mind that you can try no more than **3 times** to pass an exam.

Behave responsibly!

The university does what it can to help the environment. Join us in maintaining the conditions to preserve our planet Earth.



Save energy!

If everyone at the dorms makes 2 cups of tea with one liter of hot water per day, we will needlessly pay EUR 12,000 for electricity consumption per year. Heat only the water you need, switch off unnecessary lights, turn off electronic devices that are not in use.

Save water!

When using the toilet, consider if it is possible to use a smaller flush button. Take brisk showers and do not leave the tap open unnecessarily.



Sort waste!

The management of sorted waste is five times cheaper than mixed waste. By sorting the waste, you help the environment and also your budget. Rising expenses affect the rent at our dormitories.

Sorting recycled waste

In the Czech Republic 3 out of 4 citizens sort and recycle their waste. You can also help to preserve a healthy environment by learning how to properly sort waste. The rules differ from country to country but also from city to city! Here's how it works in Hradec.



Papír = paper For clean paper of all sorts.



Plast = plastic PET bottles, clean plastic packaging and also TetraPak (e.g., milk box).



Sklo = glass There are two types – clear and the rest (green, brown mostly).

Bio = bio waste Only organic waste from kitchen.



Směsný odpad = general waste Simply everything else.



Kov = metal

Sometimes there are also these gray containers that are used for metal (empty drink cans, broken but clean kitchen utensils and food cans).



STAG

IS/STAG is an information system designed to electronically manage your STudy AGenda at UHK. It facilitates a wide range of functions from the admissions procedure to the award of a degree. You can use it to **manage your study programmes, courses, study** plans and **student mobility**, or to **enroll in courses, apply for exams, write assessments**, to record Bachelor's and Master's dissertations, **set timetables**, and do much more.

Logging into STAG

The system is available at stag.uhk.cz – sign in with your login details. Your username is the first 5 letters of your surname and 2 letters from your given name + 1 digit (e.g. surnana1).

UHK Student Card

One of the things that you definitely cannot live without at UHK is your **UHK Student Card**. It comes in the form of an ID chip card. Let's call it an ID Card.

Your ID Card gives you access to a wide range of services. Use it to print and copy documents, borrow books, establish your identity, and access UHK buildings and lockers.

Your ID Card will be handed to you after your arrival, make sure to keep it safe!

Photocopying and printing

There are several self-service **photocopiers** at UHK. You can also scan documents and **send them to your e-mail**. You need a valid **ID Card with enough credit** to use these services.

Printing:

- 1 Open your document in a PC connected to the university network.
- 2 In printing menu, select *SafeQ_Ricoh_PCL6_UNI* on *forkys3.uhk.cz* printer and send the job to the print queue.
- 3 Go to a printer at UHK, sign in with ID Card.
- 4 Select the document from the list and press the icon for printing.
- 5 Log out after printing all your documents!

If you need any help, please contact the Service Center where you can also add credit to your ID Card.

Topping up your ID Card

You can top up credit on your ID card at top-up points (building A in front of A1). The minimum amount of credit is CZK 20 and the maximum amount is CZK 1,500. Prices for photocopying and printing can be found in the Service Center's current price list.



Any unused balance on your card is non-refundable.

Accommodation in HK

If you want to stay at the dorms, **don't leave things until the last minute and plan ahead. You really need to apply before you get to Hradec!** Vacancies are usually first offered to international students.

University Halls of Residence

The Palachovy Halls of Residence (referred to as *"Palachárny"*) are a huge complex with 7 entrances and can house up to 869 students.

Students must follow the UHK Halls of Residence Rules.

Entering the dorms is only permitted with a valid UHK student card (or ISIC). Upon arrival, those without a card will receive a temporary loaner card.



Before moving in, each student must pay a refundable deposit of CZK 2,000.

Please take special note that the accommodation period ends sooner than the semester (end of the examination period). So, it may happen that you will need to look for alternative accommodation.

University library

The UHK Library is located in Building A. Use the **Advanced Rapid Library** catalogue to look up individual titles – arl.uhk.cz.

An indispensable part of the library's offer are e-sources – expert databases and e-books. Browse through the scientific databases with **EBSCO Discovery Service** (EDS).



If you need a book that the UHK Library does not have, use the **inter-library borrowing service** (MVS).

The complaint to investigate a violation of the **Code** can be made by submitting it via e-mail **<u>etickakomise@uhk.cz</u>** or physically in paper form to the UHK Registrar.

The Ethics Committee handles all complaints regarding violations of the Code. The Rules of procedure of the Ethics Committee UHK define further details and requirements for filing a complaint.

UHK condemns all forms of violence and, in the context of sexually motivated violence, recommends using the instructions in the following video.
