FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE AND STUDENT EMPLOYMENT

More than 90 percent of international students received financial assistance/scholarships through the Nonresident Tuition Waiver (NTW) program. Degree-seeking international students who qualify for admission are given consideration for NTW awards, which reduce tuition by \$5,300-\$7,200, depending on academic achievement. NTW awards are renewable for four years.

Many international students work on campus. Continuing students are eligible to apply for more than 100 foundation scholarships after they have finished two semesters. For more information regarding tuition, student job and scholarships, visit **uwsuper.edu/oip/costs**.

ENGLISH LANGUAGE PROGRAM AND CONDITIONAL ADMISSION

English Language and Culture Institute (ELCI) is a full time intensive English language program located just 20 minutes from UW-Superior on the campus of the University of Minnesota Duluth (UMD). Students who are academically qualified, but do not meet the UW-Superior English proficiency requirement (TOEFL: 61 / IELTS: 5.5/Duolingo 100) are eligible for conditional admission.

Conditionally admitted students can enroll at UW-Superior after they have successfully completed their studies at ELCI. No TOEFL or IELTS or Duolingo is required. ELCI students live on the UMD campus, have full access to university facilities and can participate in university activities.
