Notes on numbers

The numbers assigned to the objects are the catalogue numbers used by the STAK. The prefixes TO (*Textile Objekte*) and KG (*Kleider und Geschichten*) indicate which sub-collection the objects belong to. The main difference between the sub-collections is the amount of available background material. Objects in *Kleider und Geschichten* have extended histories, called *Object Biographies*. These biographies vary in detail, length and focus based on where and how the object was collected. Objects in *Textile Objekte* have less, or no, background information.
